VENTURA COUNTY PUBLIC HEALTH NURSING STUDENT PRECEPTOR PROGRAM

The Public Health Nursing Administration collaborates with nursing schools to provide comprehensive and diverse clinical experiences. A certified Public Health Nurse (PHN) preceptor facilitates the public health experiences for students in Accelerated Bachelor of Science in Nursing (ABSN), Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN), Masters in the Science of Nursing (MSN) and nursing doctorate programs during their rotation. Placements are available throughout the year determined based on the availability of PHNs to precept.

Eligibility Criteria:

- You must be resident of Ventura County
- You must be enrolled in a university
- The nursing school program must have a contract in place with VCPH
- You must attend a mandatory orientation with VCPH

Once PH Nursing Administration has confirmed a that a contract is in place with your school and has found a placement for you, you will be provided with a confidentiality agreement for your review and signature.

Each student will be assigned a primary PHN preceptor. The primary preceptor will coordinate a variety of experiences that will assist in meeting the public health clinical requirements of their nursing program.

Before you can begin your rotation at VCPH, students are required to attend a mandatory orientation.
