

California Children's Services (CCS)


Provides medical case management and authorizations for clients under age 21 with complex medical conditions. Facilitates treatment authorizations for the CCS-eligible condition to cover necessary medical services and ensures care from approved specialists. For more information, call (805) 981-5281.

CCS Medical Therapy Program (MTP)

Provides medically necessary occupational and physical therapy services as well as medical therapy conference services to children and young adults under the age of 21 with CCS MTP eligible conditions. Examples include cerebral palsy, muscular dystrophy, juvenile rheumatoid arthritis, burns, and traumatic brain injuries. For more information, call (805) 981-5281.

WHO DO WE SERVE

Public Health works with and supports community-based organizations and healthcare providers, particularly communities identified as having greater health disparities and reduced access to care, to improve health outcomes.



Birth and Death Registration

Oversees registration of all births and deaths that occur in Ventura County. Certified birth and death certificate copies are available for purchase for the current and prior year only. Call the Vital Records Office at (805) 981-5172 for fees. Certified copies for all other years are available through the Recorder's Office at (805) 654-2295.

GENERAL SERVICES

Emergency Medical Services Agency (EMS)

Provides statutory and regulatory directed system guidance and oversight through pre-hospital provider driven policy development and a comprehensive quality improvement program. EMS provides state certification of EMTs and locally accredits paramedic personnel; coordinates the countywide cardiac, stroke and trauma care systems; administers ambulance transportation contracts; and approves EMS education programs. Emergency Preparedness Office (EPO)

Coordinates countywide medical/health disaster preparedness functions through federally-funded grant programs. EPO oversees and coordinates local medical/health emergency plans and manages the Ventura County Medical Reserve Corps and the Ventura County Health Care Coalition. Health Care For All

Clients are screened for eligibility to all available healthcare programs for families in Ventura County and provided with application assistance for Medi-Cal, Covered California, and County's Self Pay Discount Program. For assistance, call (805) 981-5212 or 1-866-481-7674.



Childhood Lead Poisoning Prevention Program

Provides lead poisoning prevention, screening, education, case management, and referral services. For more information, call (805) 981-5291.

Child Passenger Safety Program

Provides education and training to the community on child passenger safety through workshops and hands on car seat education. For more information, call (805) 981-5225.

Child Injury Prevention Program

Provides education to the community on preventing unintentional injuries to children. Topics include pedestrian safety, wheeled sports safety, drowning prevention, child passenger safety, etc. For more information, call (805) 981-5225.

Chronic Disease Prevention

Conducts outreach and education for the prevention and control of chronic conditions, such as type 2 diabetes. Offers opportunities for physical activity, including free Zumba and Seated Tai Chi for adults. For more information, call (805) 981-6634.

Growing Together Workshops

Public Health Nurses provide workshops at local school sites to educate parents and their children about healthy adolescent development. For more information, call (805) 981-5115 or 1-800-781-4449.

Healthy Homes Ventura County

Remediates or removes lead hazards from the interior or exterior of privately-owned single-family residential properties built before 1978. Coordinates resources to integrate health and safety risk assessments, lead hazard control, and housing rehabilitation for property owners. Call (805) 981-5228 to determine eligibility.

CalFresh Healthy Living

Provides nutrition workshops, healthy recipe demonstrations, support and materials to create vegetable gardens, as well as promotes physical activity for all ages. To request services, call (805) 981-6650.

Tobacco Education and Prevention

Provides resources and referrals for the Call It Quits program and Tobacco Education and Prevention services. For more information, call (805) 201-STOP(7867).

Adolescent Family Life Program

Public Health Social Workers provide home visitation services to eligible expectant or parenting teens. Services include case management, education, assistance with school retention, and support for developing parenting skills and achieving social and economic independence. General Field Nursing

Public Health Nurses provide home visits for individuals of any age and families in the community. Nurses assist with healthcare access, education, medical case management, and other public health nursing services. For more information, call (805) 981-5115 or 1-800-781-4449.

Nurse-Family Partnership

Public Health Nurses provide regular home visits to first-time mothers starting as early as their first trimester (but no later than 28 weeks gestation) and through their child's second birthday. Goals are to improve pregnancy outcomes, child health and development, and the family's economic self-sufficiency through education, support, and resources. Parents as Teachers

Public Health Social Workers support and engage parents and caregivers to promote the early development, learning, and health of children. Eligible participants include parents or caregivers of children under 12 months, and pregnant individuals who are currently receiving CalWORKS. For more information, call (805) 981-5193.

Perinatal Substance Use

Public Health Nurses work with providers to coordinate services for pregnant women at risk for substance use. Nurses provide follow-up home visits and support to those identified as meeting the program criteria. For more information, call (805) 981-5115 or 1-800-781-4449.

Rx for Kids and Families

Public Health Nurses coordinate preventative health and wellness care for children involved with the Child Welfare System. Nurses work with at-risk children to promote health and safety for children at home. For more information, call (805) 981-5190.

INFECTIOUS DISEASE SERVICES

Communicable Disease

Conducts surveillance for the detection, control, and prevention of over 85 mandated reportable diseases, as well as disease outbreaks and emerging diseases in Ventura County. HIV/AIDS Center

Provides HIV screening, case management, treatment assistance, and oversight of the syringe replacement program. Anonymous and confidential HIV testing and counseling is available. For more information, call (805) 652-6267 or to schedule an appointment, call (805) 652-3342.

Immunization Program and California Immunization Registry (CAIR)

Provides immunization information and education to the public, physicians, clinics, hospitals, child-care centers, and schools. Coordinates free community flu events each Fall and provides free case management to Perinatal Hepatitis B patients. For more information, call (805) 981-5211. Public Health Clinics

Provides services such as child and adult immunizations for those who qualify, travel vaccines, pregnancy tests, family planning education, screening and treatment for sexually transmitted infections. To schedule an appointment, call (805) 981-5221 or 1-888-285-5012.

Public Health Laboratory

Provides communicable disease testing to support public health programs, environmental health, and animal control. Performs specialized diagnostic testing for infectious diseases and water quality. Collaborates with area physicians to coordinate disease investigation efforts with State and National Laboratories. For more information, call (805) 981-5131.

Tuberculosis (TB) Specialty Clinic

Conducts TB screening, contact investigation, nurse and physician evaluations, and training and consultation with medical providers. Provides medication to prevent and treat tuberculosis, as well as community education. For more information, call (805) 385-9451.
